Skerton St Luke's Sports Funding

The staff at Skerton St Luke's work hard to ensure that all children take part in a high quality and enjoyable Physical Education curriculum. We also provide a wide range of extra-curricular sports and activities to enhance this and take part in many different sporting competitions at a number of different levels.

During 2015-16, the school received £8600 funding to develop school sport and P.E. As in previous years this funding has been/is being used to:

- Enter into the Our Lady's Catholic College Sports
 Partnership, which organises many inter-school competitions, provides specialist coaching and CPD for staff, provides consultancy on Outdoor Education, provides resources and offers a number of opportunities for pupils to develop their leadership skills.
- Work with specialist coaches with links to local clubs such as Heysham Golf Club, Morecambe Football Club, Ludus Dance, Lancashire Cricket Board, Lancaster Bulldogs Wheelchair Basketball and Pedal and Scoot Cycling.
- Provide more opportunities for children who don't take part in a lot of physical activity outside the curriculum such as 'Change for Life' events.

- Improve participation levels in extra-curricular clubs and competitions throughout the school by offering a range of different clubs to suit different tastes and age groups.
- Fund the maintenance and renewal of existing resources as well as purchase any new resources needed.
- Encourage safe cycling to school with a dedicated programme for Y5 and Y6.
- Further enhance the Outdoor Education provision being offered to upper KS2 children by offering a subsidised Outdoor and Adventurous residential stay.
- Travel to and from events using the school minibus.
