

Personal, Social & Emotional

This term we will be thinking about ourselves - our feelings, our families and our school. We will be encouraged to have the confidence to speak freely and attempt new tasks. We will be discussing class and school expectations, positive behaviour and settling into our new learning environment. We will be encouraged to make the right choices to become more aware of ourselves as an individual and how our actions affect others.

Physical development

We will be doing PE on a Wednesday. We will develop confidence using large and small apparatus, develop skills to use a range of equipment and learn how to control and co-ordinate our bodies playing games. We will learn about the importance of space. We will develop our fine motor skills and focus on pencil control, using scissors safely and other hand held tools. We will use the outside area daily to encourage large movement to improve our physical and large muscle development.

Understanding the world

We will be talking about our families and people who help us. We will be using ICT to play simple games and program BEEbots to make them move. We will be exploring our surroundings as "Autumn Hunters" to make observations at this exciting time of year. We will explore Christianity and that we are all special in God's eyes.

Expressive arts and design

We will experiment with different art resources such as paint, clay, chalk and crayons to explore mark making large and small.

We will create models using the technique of junk modelling and learn how to join materials together.

We will mix colours and produce pictures and paintings for our "Let's Create" gallery in class. We will learn new songs and use different musical instruments to explore making different sounds, our bodies included.

We will play in role in the home corner and learn more about families and how we live.

Communication & Language

We will be encouraged to talk every day through a range of activities such as role-play, story telling using puppets and sharing personal experiences. We will also learn how important it is to listen to others, follow instructions and concentrate on a task. We will participate in small speaking and listening activities every day to develop our listening skills, use of vocabulary and understanding. We take turns speaking using "Chatty Ratty" during circle activities.

Outcome:

We will host a "Starting School" celebration for parents to attend - an afternoon stay & play session in class with juice, cakes & biscuits where parents can view their child's learning journey. Date to be confirmed.

Mathematics

We will be counting up to 10 and beyond to 20. We will sing number and action rhymes together.

We will be recognising numbers up to 10 and matching to a set of objects.

We will begin basic addition work, combining two groups together and talking about more and less.

We will be exploring 2D and 3D shapes, the days of the week and learning the months in the year to complete our class birthday chart. We will talk about positional language and movement in PF

Literacy

We will all take part in story time every day. We will be encouraged to mark make using a range of equipment, pencils, felt tips, sticks in the mud, etc, to develop our fine motor skills and begin to learn the correct letter formation with a 'whoosh' to get started. We will begin the program Jolly Phonics to learn letters and sounds and learn how to recognise and write our name and other things such as labels, captions.
