R.E -

We are focusing on the Christian values of Faith, Respect and Reverence. We are asking the questions;

What does 'Church' mean? Are all Churches the same?

What does it mean to belong to a Church?

Science -

We are looking at living things and their habitats. The children will;

- Recognise that living things can be grouped in a variety of ways.
- Explore and use classification keys to help group, identify and name a variety of living things in their local and wider environment.
- Construct and interpret a variety of food chains, identifying producers, predators and prey.
- Recognise that environments can change and that this can sometimes pose dangers to living things.
- Use and make identification keys for plants and animals.

DT

Our focus is Food. We will be designing and making a savoury meal. We will think about; Product - what could we make? Purpose - what is it for? User - who is going to use it? This will link in with food grown in different climates and food to sustain life - The eatwell plate.
