Dear parent/ carer,

It is a very scary time and many of you are feeling worried about your families and loved ones contracting the virus. Some of you are worried about how you will cope if we have to go back into full lockdown and many of you are fearful for your jobs and work environments. Please be assured you are all doing ok.

What I see is: parents getting their children to school on time each day, you all trying really hard to be on time and not leave your children waiting at the end of the day. I see lovey smiles (even in your eyes) and hear warm greetings as you come through those gates each day. I notice that your children are wearing the correct uniform (school or PE), mostly on the correct days. I see children completing homework and reading to an adult as often as they can and I feel so proud of you all.

The biggest thing to note is that in amongst all of this anxiety and worry, our children are doing really well. They are happy in school, they are together and catching up on lost learning. They are tired at the end of the half term but they are also playing together well and showing kindness towards each other. Be proud of all we have achieved together this half term and whatever comes our way in the next few weeks we will continue to do all we can to keep the children safe, happy and learning together.
