## Story focus: Whatever Next!

### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- What can we do to look after our amazing world?
- Talk about how we can be kind to each other and show that we care about people, objects and the world we live in.

### Expressive Arts and Design

- Collect your rubbish this week and build a marvelous machine to take you into space.
- Draw a space picture – talk about it!
- Role-play going on a space adventure.

### Communication and Language

- Learn a new word – **astronaut.**

### Physical Development

- Moon walk and dance to some space music.
- Talk about the effects of exercise before, during and after.
- Make your own space music – use pots and pans, dried pasta in shakers, your voice and percussion using your body like clicking, clapping, patting your knees.

### Understanding the World

- Take a photograph of your marvelous space machine. Put it in your portfolio on Class Dojo's.
- Learn an interesting fact about the moon.
- Plan and enjoy a picnic with your family.

### Literacy

- Practice reading, spelling and writing Phase 2 Tricky words **I no the to into go**
- Share a story together every day. Online stories can be accessed via Book Trust and Oxford Owl for free. CBeebies bedtime stories are great too!
- **Listen to the story “Whatever Next” by Jill Murphy on YouTube.**
- Talk about the story and what happens.
- Write a list of things you will take on your space mission.

### Mathematics

- Count from 0-10 and back again until secure. Blast your rocket into space, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5...and so on!
- Write the numerals 1-10.
- Put a number on the bottom stair and count on as you walk up.
- Put a number on the top stair and count back from that number as you walk down.
- Talk about the 2D and 3D shapes you use to build your marvelous space machine.
